Feast of Christ the King

This Sunday, **October 29** is the Feast of Christ the King. The Church asks us to lovingly profess our loyalty and submission to our Divine King by renewing our consecration to his most Sacred Heart after all Masses. After the 10:30 a.m. Mass, there will be Exposition of Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament, the chanting of Christus Vincit, recitation of the Act of Consecration of the Human Race to the Sacred Heart of Jesus and Benediction (approximately 15 minutes).

The usual conditions to obtain a plenary indulgence are: praying for the intentions of the Holy Father, receiving Holy Communion that same day, confessing within the month and having a detachment from sin. There are handouts at the church entrances on how to gain an indulgence.
