For the Feast of the Purification this Friday, **February 2**, there will be the blessing of candles, a procession and a sung Mass beginning at 6:00 p.m. If you cannot attend and have candles to be blessed, please bring them any time before this Mass and leave them in the work sacristy (with your name). After the blessing, they will be available for pick up in the work sacristy. There will be a low Mass at 11:00 a.m. that day, but the blessing is only imparted at the sung Mass. Please note the Friday Holy Hour will occur before the 6:00 p.m. Mass (from 5:00 p.m.-5:50 p.m.).

### Feast of St. Blaise

After the 9:00 a.m. Mass this Saturday, **February 3**, the [blessing of throats](#) with candles [blessed in honor of St. Blaise](#) will be imparted. For those who cannot attend this Mass and would like to receive the blessing privately after another Mass, please contact either Fr. Romanoski or Fr. Truong.

Katie Anderson will be speaking at St. Mary's on Saturday, **February 10** at 5:00 p.m. with a presentation entitled “Confronting the Lies: My Struggle with Gender Dysphoria.” Having undergone medical intervention for gender dysphoria as a teenager and living as a “man” for seven years, Katie eventually sought guidance from the church, leading her to embrace her true God-given identity. Hormone therapy and sex reassignment surgeries for minors are happening here in RI at Hasbro Children's Hospital. There will be legislation introduced this year that makes these procedures illegal for children in RI. This event, which is organized by Rhode Island Family Institute, Massachusetts Family Institute and Servants of Christ, will spearhead that legislative effort.
