Presentation-Transition Regret

Katie Anderson will be speaking at St. Mary's on Saturday, **February 10** at 5:00 p.m. with a presentation entitled "Confronting the Lies: My Struggle with Gender Dysphoria." Having undergone medical intervention for gender dysphoria as a teenager and living as a "man" for seven years, Katie eventually sought guidance from the church, leading her to embrace her true God-given identity.

Hormone therapy and sex reassignment surgeries for minors are happening here in RI at Hasbro Children's Hospital. There will be legislation introduced this year that makes these procedures illegal for children in RI. This event, which is organized by Rhode Island Family Institute, Massachusetts Family Institute and Servants of Christ, will spearhead that legislative effort.
