Renewal of Consecration of FSSP to the Immaculate Heart of Mary

As was done last year, the FSSP will renew its consecration of its members and our apostolates to the Immaculate Heart of Mary this Sunday, **February 11** after the 10:30 a.m. Mass. This Sunday is the feast of Our Lady of Lourdes. The consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary has brought many blessings in return!

Ash Wednesday

The holiest season of the year is about to begin! The season commences mid-week before the First Sunday of Lent so as to complete exactly 40 days of penance in union with Our Divine Redeemer's 40 days of fasting in the desert. Although it is not an obligation to attend Mass that day, it is an obligation to do penance. Catholics age 14+ must abstain from meat while those ages 18-59 must abstain from meat and fast. Fasting consists of eating just one main meal along with two collations/snacks, which together would not equal a main meal. There is no better way to begin this season as a faithful friend of Christ crucified than by attending Mass and receiving ashes. It is a reminder of one's mortality and a sign of one's commitment to do penance. Ashes will be distributed at all Masses: **7:00 a.m., 11:00 a.m., 7:00 p.m. (sung).**

Stations of the Cross—Fridays during Lent

The Stations of the Cross will be prayed every Friday during Lent after the 11:00 a.m. Mass. Booklets will be available at the side entrance of the church. A plenary indulgence is gained under the usual conditions for praying the Stations. In addition, a plenary indulgence is gained for praying before a Crucifix on Fridays during Lent. Holy cards with this prayer will also be available at the side entrance of the church.

Lenten Days of Recollection at St. Mary's Save the Date

On Saturday, **March 9** from 8:30 a.m.-2:00 p.m., there will be a retreat for women with rosary, Mass (9:00 a.m.), spiritual reflections, lunch and Adoration.

On Saturday, **March 16** from 1:30 p.m.-7:00 p.m., there will be a retreat for men with Mass (2:00 p.m.), spiritual reflections, Adoration and a cookout.

Pro-Life Rosary
