Church Attire

An ever relevant reminder from our founder, Fr. Berg: "With the warm summer months upon us, it is important to recall that not all attire is appropriate for church. Just as the atmosphere in the house of God ought to be distinct from everyday life outside; so too our dress should reflect the particular solemnity of this place. We are fortunate to have an edifice whose surroundings elevate the mind and heart to God; our comportment ought to always do the same.

More specifically, both men and women should wear clothing which covers at least the knees and shoulders, and has sleeves—no shorts, short skirts or tank tops. It is important that we make sure that all who visit St. Mary's can see immediately by our dress and our behavior that we are truly in a sanctuary, a place set aside for the worship of the One, True God, whom we strive to adore with our entire being."

Blessing of Items

A reminder that items for blessings can be placed in the work sacristy on the cabinet immediately to the right upon entering. There are shelves for items "to be blessed" and for items that have already been "blessed". Fr. Romanoski and Fr. Truong will try to bless items on Sundays after the 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Masses.
