This Thursday, **August 15** is the feast of the Assumption, a Holy Day of obligation to honor Our Lady's principal feast day of her entrance into heaven. There is a special blessing of Herbs, Flowers, and Fruit on the Feast of the Assumption, which will be given after all the Masses.

Installation of Air Conditioning

From Fr. Romanowski

The process of installing air conditioning in the church has begun. The parking area between the rectory, church and dumpster will be fenced off for two weeks as they dig to run the power lines. This will also serve as a much-needed opportunity to level and repave that area. Please use parking adjacent to the school or on the street. Also, please use the front door (facing Broadway) for any office appointments. Thank you for your patience.

Air conditioning will be a great consolation during the hot summer months when the church temperature rises higher than the temperature outside. It will serve to keep our church clean and quiet without leaving the windows open, which brings in much dust and noise, and will offset the humidity, which gradually does damage to the paintings and interior. It will also help preserve our sacred vestments and cassocks from being sullied by sweat in the even warmer sanctuary.

The air-conditioning units use the latest efficient technology to push out air from vents on the outer aisles under the stations of the cross. It is estimated to have a low cost during the few months of use. It should take a number of months to complete the project of installing the units, running the duct work through the basement ceiling and awaiting ordered parts. We are ever grateful to David Vise for overseeing the project. We will reinstate the prayer to St. Joseph to whom we trust for the project's successful execution.

The estimated total cost will be around \$300,000. We have about that much in our savings, which we should not leave depleted. A generous parishioner has offered to match any donations given in the next three months for this project. Thus, your generosity will be doubly rewarded in this life and the next! Please use the Capitol Improvement budget envelope or those marked for AC at the entrances to the church, or simply mark your check or online donation for that said purpose.
