With over 400 registered households and approximately 800 public Masses per year, there will be an initial limit of **eight** Mass requests per household for 2025. After Easter, the limit per household may increase if available Masses remain open. Please note there are slots reserved each week for urgent requests or recent deaths (on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays or private Masses). Public Mass intentions may only be requested by registered parishioners of St. Mary's. #### **Sacramental Preparation Classes**

We will begin supplementary preparation classes for candidates for First Holy Communion and Confirmation beginning Sunday, **January 12**. Candidates will meet in their respective classes from 9:45 a.m.-10:15 a.m. every Sunday from **January 12 into May**, unless otherwise noted (like Palm Sunday and Easter).
