Epiphany Mass Schedule

Monday, **January 6** is the feast of the Epiphany, one of the universal holy days of the Church and the manifestation of Our Lord to the Gentiles, represented by the Three Kings—SS. Caspar, Melchior and Balthasar. Although not a holy day of obligation in the US, all are encouraged to come to Mass that day. The special schedule of Masses is 7:00 a.m. (low), 11:00 a.m. (low) and 7:00 p.m. (sung).

Sacramental Preparation Classes


