Project Updates

Below are updates on the various projects at St. Mary's.

- Air-conditioning in the church was successfully installed. St. Mary's received a \$54,000 rebate for using a clean energy source.
- Beautiful cabinets around the air-conditioning units were installed this week for protection and a more decorous appearance. They will be stained shortly.
- A Sacred Heart statue was acquired and will be placed on the other side of the air-conditioning units, parallel with the Our Lady of Fatima statue. Each area will be beautified with flowers in the Spring.
- The work sacristy, baptistry and vesting sacristies were repainted with the removal of dirt and cracked paint.
- Another room in the church basement was painted. The cleaning and organization of the basement continues in order to create a more dignified meeting place for the many parish groups.
