### Blessing of Candles

This Sunday, **February 2** is the Feast of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary, also known as Candlemas. The blessing of candles and the procession will begin five minutes before the 10:30 a.m. Mass. Only the acolytes will receive candles and will process within the church due to weather and sidewalk conditions. The procession replaces the Asperges and prayers at the foot of the altar. If you have candles you would like blessed, please hold onto them, and they will be blessed from the communion rail.

### Blessing of Throats

The blessing of throats with candles blessed in honor of St. Blaise will be imparted this Monday, **February 3** after both Masses. For those who cannot attend and would like to receive the blessing privately after another Mass, please let us know. "By the intercession of St. Blaise, bishop and martyr, may God deliver you from every malady of the throat, and from every other malady; in the name of the Father, and of the Son, + and of the Holy Ghost. R. Amen."

### Redeem the Time

To facilitate one's spiritual reading with the advantages of audio, please note the myriad of collections of the complete works of St. Francis de Sales, St. Alphonsus, Chesterton, etc. published on Kindle by Catholic Way. Kindle works can be played as audio on the Amazon Alexa app, and both apps can be managed from your phone for free. "Speechify" is also highly recommended for reading any content out loud with optional voices and languages.

### Novena—Renewal of Consecration

The FSSP will renew its consecration to Our Lady of Lourdes in thanksgiving for her never-failing protection. The Novena from **February 2-10** will consist of a decade of the rosary and the *Memorare* and will be recited after all daily Masses. On Tuesday, **February 11** we will recite the consecration after both Masses that day. Please attend in person or via our livestream. There will be pamphlets with the prayers at the entrances to the church.
