New Organ

St. Mary's 95-year old organ is nearing its end, as perhaps has been noticed of late. It is in need of repairs that would total several hundred thousand dollars. After much research and consultation with organ specialists, we have opted to go with a new organ console from Meta OrganWorks, which has incorporated the latest and greatest technology of Hauptwerk. This technology has meticulously digitalized the sounds of some of the greatest organs in the world (Notre Dame, Salzburg, etc.), all of which can be played off their system, and for which the spacious acoustic of St. Mary's is perfectly suited. The total price for the new console and installation is 125k and requires little to no upkeep. The organ pipes will remain, and the new system can be tied into them as well. A gracious benefactor has stepped forward offering a matching pledge, so it could cost us as little as 62k as a community. The matching pledge will run until Easter when we hope to have the new console installed. If you would like to make a contribution, kindly use the Capital Improvement budget envelope or those marked for "New Organ" at the entrances to the church.
