Votive candles cost \$3. The *merit* of lighting one is that little sacrifice of support for the church to be burnt for one's intention. Payment can be made in the drop boxes adjacent to the candles.

### Scheduling of Mass Intentions

Each household can schedule up to **eight** Mass intentions for 2026. As in previous years, this annual limit may increase if available Masses remain open. Please note there are slots reserved each week for urgent requests or recent deaths (on Tuesdays, Thursdays, Saturdays or private Masses). Public Mass intentions may only be requested by registered parishioners of St. Mary's. To make a request and pay the stipend (\$15), please visit the Mass Intentions page on the parish website.

### Video Guardian Angel

Avoid viewing occasions of sin and offenses to God by editing what you watch via VidAngel, a service which allows one to watch movies or shows excluding profanity, indecent scenes, etc. It can be linked to entertainment providers such as Netflix, Amazon Prime, etc.

### Blessing of Items

Items for blessings can be placed in the work sacristy on the cabinet immediately to the right upon entering the sacristy. There are shelves for items to be blessed and for items that have already been blessed. Fr. Romanoski and Fr. Quirke will try to bless items on Sundays after the 8:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. Masses. Occasionally, there are urgent pastoral matters that need attention which might cause a delay.


