Renewal of Consecration

The FSSP will renew its consecration to the Immaculate Heart of Mary and her never failing protection. The preparation, which members and the faithful are invited to do this month, consists of a daily decade of the rosary and the *Memorare*. The consecration will be recited after all Masses on Wednesday, **February 11**. Of note, the FSSP Superior General and Founder were recently blessed to obtain an audience with His Holiness Pope Leo XIV.


