

Proper Etiquette

As a matter of proper etiquette, there is no genuflection or deep bowing given to the processional cross when passing by. Genuflections are only proper to the cross for Good Friday exposition and for a procession in which the bishop imparts his blessing. A relic of the true cross is also revered with a genuflection. A head bow is how the sacred ministers reverence the cross before processing. The faithful can imitate with a head bow when the cross passes by.

Mass Attendance

A reminder that a moderately serious cause disoblige one from attending a Mass of obligation. Missing Mass due to a legitimate excuse does not incur sin or the need for confession. No dispensation is needed in these cases as it is just a prudential judgement of the individual. For anyone who can't attend a Mass, we livestream all our Masses at our YouTube channel.


