Organ Recital

Save the Date and Spread the Word

St. Mary's will host an organ recital with world renowned organist Dr. Michal Szostak on Saturday, **May 30** at 3:00 p.m. He will play works from Buxtehude, Beethoven, and Albéniz and improvise an Italian concerto and an American suite on St. Mary's meta organ, which is featured on the cover of the May 2026 issue of *The American Organist*. The event is a wonderful opportunity to showcase our superb new organ console and introduce people to St. Mary's. Attendance is free, though voluntary donations are welcome and will be put towards the Kilgen pipe organ restoration fund. Dr. Szostak performs dozens of recitals annually throughout the world. His current North American tour includes stops in New Bedford, Los Angeles, Reno, Grand Rapids, and Toronto.

- *Dietrich Buxtehude (1637-1707): Prelude, Fugue and Ciaccona C-dur, BuxWV 137*
- *Improvisation: Italian Concerto: Allegro-Andante-Presto*
- *Ludwig van Beethoven (1770-1827), Allegro con brio from 5th Symphony, Op. 67*
- *Isaac Albéniz (1860-1909): Asturias (Leyenda) from Suite española, Op. 47*
- *Improvisation: American Suite: Prelude-Cantabile-Final*

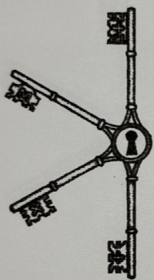
