### Gratitude and Prayers

From Fr. Romanoski: We are sad to announce that Fr. Quirke will be transferred at the end of this month. We are very grateful he was willing to come here out of season, (and for the worst winter in RI history!), when Fr. Furman left in November to help elsewhere. It has served as an excellent time for him at our most peaceful and joyful apostolate. With the ordination of 12 new men, our superiors must reshuffle the deck of assignments for this year. As a clerical candidate for the FSSP, it would be good if he experienced a bigger apostolate with at least three priests before his definitive incorporation in the future. We are grateful for his service, especially his wonderful talent for preaching, and will always remember his moving exposition on Our Lord's passion in the Holy Shroud he gave for Lent. Our prayers go with him. The best way to honor a priest is to remember what he taught you and put it into practice, as God places priests in our lives as an extension of Himself, the Good Shepherd, for our sanctification.

Fr. Quirke will lead our Corpus Christi procession and give Holy Communion to the first communicants, which he instructed this year, at the 10:30 a.m. Mass. The Coffee An' party for the first communicants will also be in honor of his priestly service here and his anniversary (8 years a priest as of June 3). Please express your thanks to him and prayers for his next assignment. He will take his vacation and retreat before his transfer, but will be around until this Thursday, and then back later in the month for a little while to pack up. Further details of his proximate assignment and replacement will be communicated when confirmed.

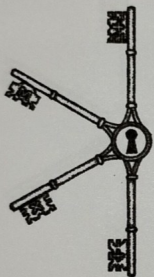
