### From Our Pastor

As previously mentioned, the North American Province must reshuffle the deck of assignments this summer with the newly ordained as well as new apostolates opening up.

Though we do not like to change pastors with much frequency, only an experienced pastor will be suited to the task of establishing or managing a new or larger apostolate to which I will be assigned.

Fr. Nicholas Eichman will be appointed as pastor in my stead. He served here at St. Mary's for two months after his ordination in 2021 before being assigned to our very large apostolate in Idaho and, subsequently, to our expanding apostolate in Sarasota, Florida. He is one of 11 siblings, 4 of whom are priests for our FSSP, along with 3 sisters who are religious. He brings great youthful energy, joy, and musical talent to his first assignment as pastor, and we trust that the dear faithful of St. Mary's will receive him with equal enthusiasm and support.

Fr. Padraic Stack, a native of Massachusetts (and a loyal Bruins and Red Sox fan), will be the new assistant. He was ordained for the Archdiocese of Omaha in 2018 where his family had moved. He is currently a clerical candidate for the FSSP in his second year. He brings good pastoral experience, a joyful spirit, and will form a great team with Fr. Eichman.

They should arrive on July 1. I will be around to assure a smooth transition and will depart sometime later in July. More details forthcoming.

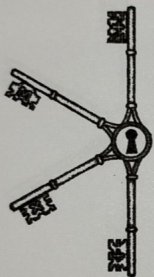
