This number should be used in case of sacramental emergencies, that is, when a person is in danger of death and is requesting the sacraments—times when a person's condition is grave or rapidly declining. This number is not for routine parish business, scheduling appointments, questions about parish events, or non-urgent matters. For these requests, please contact the parish office via the regular communication methods. For convenience sake, feel free to save the emergency number in your contacts. It will be monitored at all times by the priests.

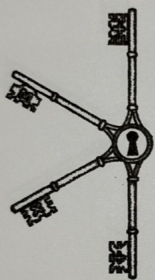
